

TE RERENGA STREAM

Te Rerenga is a part of a boundary separating Waitaha and Tapuika. This stream originates in the fissures in the rocks at Ōtānewainuku. Summer reduces the stream's flow to a creek, but in Winter, water soaks into the ground, builds up the water table and the volume of water into Te Rerenga increases.

On one side of Ōtānewainuku, Te Rerenga runs into the Mangatoi and on the other side it flows west to join the Waimapu River
