Waitaha Pou Ārahi Taiao is a full time position funded by Jobs for Nature for a fixed term of three years.

This role is dedicated to improving environmental outcomes that reflect Waitaha tikanga, mātauranga, values and a cultural values approach to kaitiaki responsiveness.

About the role

You will support kaitiaki programmes, practises, outcomes planning, and implementation. Other essential functions will include representing Waitaha input and response to Government, Local Government, and private sector developments. Additionally, you will work closely with kaitiaki and provide project management support to current and future kaitiaki (conservation/restoration) programmes. A further key focus will be scaling-up sustainable conservation initiatives, and attracting funding resource, that help build a future where both people, and te taio thrive.

Ideally you will have;

- an equivalent combination of environmental degree, or at least three years relative experience in environmental, conservation, project management areas
- ability to apply reo, mātauranga, and Waitaha tikanga
- experience working in an iwi orient workplace environment
- experienced at building networks capability, identifying key stakeholders/partners
- ability to present, and communicate to iwi and other public forums
- excellent report writing, and technical knowledge
- record of successful leadership
